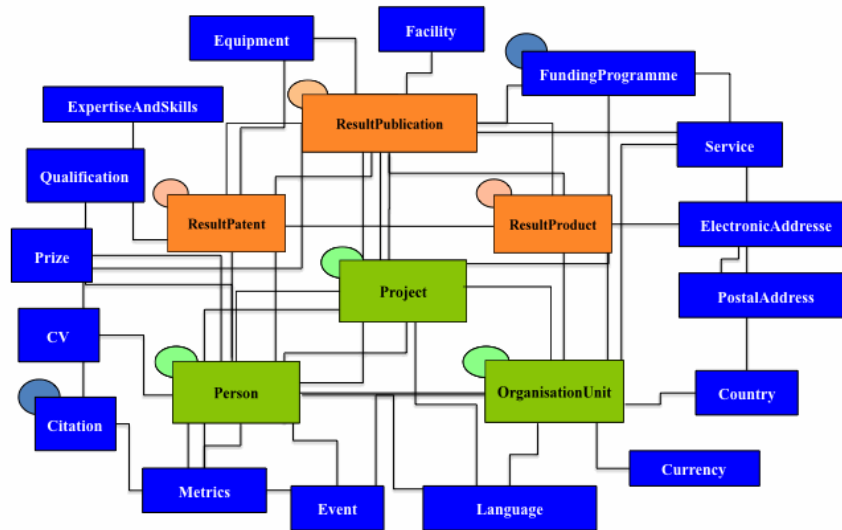


Figure 1. CERIF Entities and their Relationships

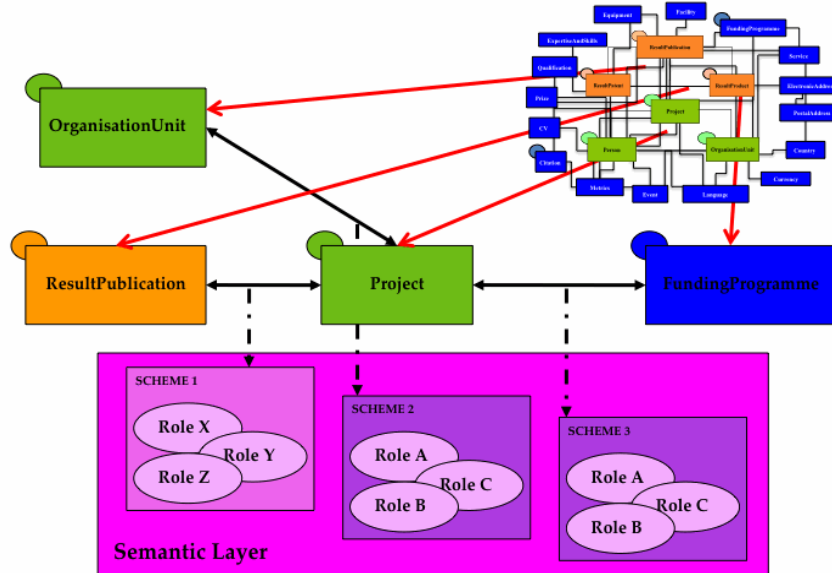


Figure 2. Some selected CERIF entities, indicating the management of their semantics within links (simplified view)
